You can direct tax dollars to benefit Healthy NewsWorks!

Pennsylvania's Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) allows you to choose exactly where a portion of your taxes go!

Businesses that pay state taxes in Pennsylvania can make a contribution to Healthy NewsWorks and receive up to 90% of that contribution back in the form of a tax credit.

The EITC tax credit means that your business can donate up to 90 cents of its qualifying state tax dollar to Healthy NewsWorks. The funds will go directly to support our curriculum, increase the number of participating students in our programs, and expand our impact in school communities.

2021 Application Timeline

May 17: Businesses that have fulfilled their 2-year commitment may apply for another 2-year commitment

May 17: Businesses that have completed the first year of a 2-year commitment may apply for the second year of tax credits

July 1: All businesses, including initial applicants and applicants wishing to submit an additional application on top of a previously submitted 2-year commitment, may apply
